The West Bengal Mangar Development Board was formed vide notification no. 5085-BCW/6S-26/2025 dated 30.12.2025 with its head office at Kalimpong. The Board's main objective is to preserve and promote Mangar language as well as Mangar heritage. It also aims to take up social Welfare activities for socio-economic development.

Functions and mandate of the Board:

- a) To undertake all necessary activities for the protection, promotion and safeguarding Mangar Language, tradition and culture.
- b) To undertake activities to protect historical and culturally significant landmarks of the community.
- c) To provide support to museum, community radio, publishing unit and mass media units;
- d) To undertake activities to popularize, promote and enhance products of artisans, farmers and other tradition based items and help the artistes and artisans engaged in traditional activities;
- e) To protect and promote customary rights of the community;
- f) To establish a centre for the protection of the Mangar heritage;
- g) To take up social welfare activities catering to the requirements of the community;
- h) To promote education among Mangar community

- i) To publish or cause to be published useful literature, papers, books, research works, magazines of the Mangar community etc.**
- j) To work in association with all Government agencies for awareness generation regarding various programme of development and social welfare, education, literacy etc.**
- k) To undertake necessary activities for natural resource management, alternative energy, ecology and environment;**

- l) To construct, maintain, improve, develop, any building, houses or other infrastructures and purchase land and other movable and immovable assets for the benefit of the community;**
- m) To promote Mangar medicinal practices;**
- n) To take up livelihood development of the community;**
- o) To undertake and provide legal assistance to protect assets of the community members;**
- p) To raise loan and credit to fulfil the objectives from national and international financial institution, subject to observation of statutory rules and executive instructions;**
- q) To obtain fund from different Government departments for fulfilment of the aforesaid objectives;**
- r) To undertake activities for the overall development of the Mangar community throughout West Bengal;**
- s) To do all such acts, deeds, matters and things connected thereto and therewith as may be necessary or deemed to be necessary as well as incidental or conducive to the forgoing objects;**

2 . Powers and duties of officers and employees of the Board. [U/s4(i)(b)(ii) of the RTI Act,2005]

The following are the authorities of the Board namely,-

a) General Body and b) Executive Body.

a)The General Body consist of 11 members

The Power and duties of the General Body:-

- i. To provide Guidelines of the activities of the Board in conformity with the objects defined;
- ii. To consider and adopt annual report of the Board;
- iii. To consider and approve the audited accounts and budget estimates;
- iv. To appoint auditor for auditing the annual accounts.

b) Executive Body:

The executive body consisting of members constituted as following by the Government from amongst the members of the general body, namely,-

i) Chairperson	:-Shri Navin Thapa Mangar
ii)Vice-Chairperson	:-Shri Diwas Thapa Mangar
iii)Member-Secretary	:-Shri Tsewang Gyatsho Bhutia
iv) Member	:- Hemant Thapa

vi)Member	:-Niraj Thapa
vii) Member	:- Tusar Thapa

The Power and duties of the Executive Body:-

- i) To manage the affairs of the body and for this purpose to constitute committees and/or sub-committees consisting of the members of the body and to frame and adopt such regulations, bye-laws and pass such orders as may appear conducive to and necessary for the efficient administration of the boards and attainment of these objects provided that such regulation shall not be repugnant to these regulations and shall be reported to the general body.
- ii) To prepare and place before the general body and annual report, the audited accounts and the budget estimates:

iii) To manage all the moveable and immovable properties belonging to the board;

iv) To keep accounts audited and budget estimate prepared, to do all other acts and deeds as shall be necessary and relevant in furtherance to the objects of the board;

v) To pay out of funds belonging to the board or out of any particular part of such fund, the expenses incurred by the board from time to time including expenses for the formation of the board and management of administration of the foregoing objects, including all rent, rates and taxes, outgoing and salaries, allowance including fringe benefits of the employees.

The Executive body exercises the power as mentioned above subject to the directives as may be issued by the State Government in Backward Classes Welfare Department from time to time.

3. Procedure followed in decision making process [Under Section 4(1)b(iii) of the RTI Act, 2005]

Meeting of the General Body:-

The General Body ordinarily meets at least twice a year on date, time and place to be fixed by the Secretary in consultation with the Chairperson and:-

- i. Adopts the annual report of the preceding year;
- ii. Passes the audited account and budget estimates
- iii. Transact any business as well placed in the agenda suggested by the executive body.

An extra-ordinary meeting of the General body may be called by the Secretary, in consultation with the Chairperson and at the advice of the Executive body when needed to transact any special business or at the requisition signed by at least four members of the Board.

The following procedures shall be applicable to all the meetings of the General Body:-

- i. One third of the members shall constitute the quorum. If there be no quorum, the meeting shall stand postponed to a date to be fixed by the Chairperson. A fresh notice shall be issued and if there be no quorum again those present shall be competent to transact business.
- ii. The chairperson or in his absence the Vice-Chairperson shall take the chair. If neither the Chairperson nor the vice-Chairperson be present the members present shall nominate a president for the meeting from amongst them and transact the business.

Meeting of the executive Body:

- i. The executive body shall ordinarily meet four times in a year and the quorum of such meeting shall be four(4).
- ii. An extra-ordinary meeting of the executive body may be called at the requisition of at least four (4) members of the Executive body to transact any special business.

4. Norms for discharge of functions [u/s 4(1)(b)(iv) of RTI Act, 2005].

• **Nature of functions/services offered:**

HOUSING:

⊕ Board may utilize funds for the Housing Scheme with embedded toilets for persons for the community.

COMMUNITY CENTRES:

⊕ Boards may use funds for construction of community Centre in the community concentrated areas, preferably on the vested/donated land. Land should be free from encumbrances.

HOSTELS:

⊕ Recommendation for Girls and Boys hostels for the students can be made by the board. Requirement of the same is to be examined and implemented by the Backward Classes Welfare Department.

⊕ Working women hostel on vested/donated land for 500/100 members may be taken up by the Board for the Women of the Community from where she cannot commute.

DRINKING WATER:

⊕ The drinking water projects may be taken up for the community.

IMPROVEMENT OF TRADITIONAL CULTURAL AND HERITAGE PLACES:

⊕ The boards may utilize funds for development and improvement of places of Cultural and Traditional importance and Heritage places considered important for the community.

DEVELOPMENT OF SPORTS FACILITIES AND WELFARE OF SPORTSPERSONS:

⊕ The boards may utilize funds for development of sports facility, welfare of sports persons and for training by the coaches accredited to the State Sports Federations etc. Associations,

TOILETS:

⊕ Places where community toilets are required and not covered under the Nirmal Bangla programme, Boards may take up construction of community toilets.

PASSENGERS SHED:

⊕ Preferably in the far off areas, the Boards may take up construction of passengers sheds.






